Scholarship Guidelines

- A total of (7) Scholarships will be awarded.
- (1) Scholarship, known as the Sam Brown Memorial Scholarship, can be awarded to a relative of a member in good standing, of the Houston Chapter, TASO-Football.
- The eligible student shall be a graduating senior from a public; private; parochial; charter or home school serviced by the Houston Chapter.
- Currently participating in high school football as either a player or trainer.
- Be enrolled in a university or college for the fall 2010 semester as a full-time student.
- Can NOT be attending college on an athletic scholarship.
- Only one student per school will be eligible.
- The student will need to demonstrate proficiency/competency in the following areas:
 - Extra-Curricular Activities
 - Community Involvement / Volunteerism
 - Citizenship

- The student will need to be pursuing a two or four-year degree at a post-secondary institution.
- The award will be a one-time stipend not to exceed \$1,000 (One-Thousand Dollars (U.S.)).
- The check will be issued by the *Houston Chapter, TASO-Football* to the bursar of said institution.
- The scholarship winner will be determined by the Houston Chapter, TASO-Football Scholarship Committee until further notice.
- The Houston Chapter, TASO-Football Scholarship Committee will consist of the Div IV Representative and a member in good standing from each of the regions (Central, North, Northwest, East & Southwest).
- The application for the scholarship shall be posted by Mid-March in each year on the website of the **Houston Chapter, TASO- Football** (www.houstonreferee.com).
- The applications will be due by April 1st. A winner will be selected prior to May 14th in that year.
