TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER

CAME ON THIS DAY before the Court Plaintiff Southwest Officials Association, Inc. d/b/a Texas Association of Sports Officials' ("TASO") Application for Temporary Restraining Order (the "Application"). The Court, having considered the pleading, the Application and the affidavits in support thereof (the "Affidavits") finds that:

(a) as it clearly appears from the specific facts shown in the pleading and the attached affidavit, imminent and irreparable injury will be inflicted upon TASO and/or its members if a temporary restraining order is not entered immediately;

(b) if not immediately so restrained, the University Interscholastic League ("UIL") will continue its efforts to usurp and take over TASO, force TASO members to leave TASO and register with the UIL in lieu of TASO, prevent those officials who have not registered with TASO from engaging in their officiating vocation, and thereby cause TASO and its members to suffer substantial and irreparable harm;

(c) TASO has a substantial likelihood of success on the merits;

(d) TASO does not have an adequate remedy at law in that, among other things, TASO will have no way to recover lost membership or to repair the damage to TASO if it is forced out of

business, and its member officials will have lost the opportunity to officiate games during the pendency of the present dispute;

(e) that Defendant UIL should be restrained as set forth herein below.

It is therefore, ORDERED ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Defendant University Interscholastic League and any persons or entities acting in connection therewith, be immediately restrained from (1) enforcing, implementing, or taking any action to effectuate the adoption of the November 6, 2009 changes to UIL Rule 1204; (2) taking any action seeking to compel, coerce, or encourage any person not to register with TASO as a sports official or to register with the UIL in lieu of registering with TASO as a sports official; (3) charging or collecting any fee, tax, or other revenue directly from any sports official as a condition of engaging in the officiating profession; and (4) ~~attempting in any way to regulate sports officiating in Texas.~~

*with the exception of any further meeting of the Legislative Council to revise or amend its Rule.*

It is further ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Plaintiff TASO shall post a bond or cash in lieu thereof in the amount of \$100.00.

It is further, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that a hearing on Plaintiff's Request for Temporary Injunction shall be set for January 19, 2010, at 9:00 a.m., on the Travis County Court Central Docket.

It is further ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that this Temporary Restraining Order shall expire and be dissolved fourteen days from the date hereof unless previously dissolved or extended by the Court or by agreement of the parties.
